# Minute Meetings

The purpose of the "Minute Meetings" is to give all students the opportunity to check-in with me. School counselors don't always get a chance to speak individually to students. These meetings provide opportunities for me to get to know each of the students I serve. Students become aware that the school counselor is a support person they can turn to in school if needed. Counselor will get student perceptions on school, personal/social relationships and future goals. Counselor may become aware of students who need support and or situations that need to be addressed. Every student receives 1:1 positive attention.
